

2018-19 Fort Knox Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits

Additional Deer Seasons:

- Tier 1-2:** Shotgun/muzzleloader: 19 - 21 October
- Shotgun/muzzleloader: 3 - 12 November
- Shotgun/muzzleloader: 12 - 23 December

* No small game or turkey hunting during the quota gun deer hunt weekends.

** Bag limit for fall archery and gun seasons combined, 1 bird per day, and no more than 1 bird may have a beard length of 3 inches or longer.

*** The Fort Knox deer bag limit is 1 antlerless deer and 1 deer of either sex with an archery permit **and** 1 antlerless deer and 1 deer of either sex with a gun permit. The cantonment area either-sex archery quota hunt for Tier 1-2 hunters is 1 additional either sex deer. The youth hunt is 1 additional either-sex deer.

All deer, turkey, and bobcat harvested at Fort Knox must be checked-in through the KDFWR's Telecheck System (www.fw.ky.gov or 1-800-245-4263) by midnight on the day it is harvested. Harvest must also be reported at check-out in the iSportsman system (<https://ftknox.isportsman.net/>).

Deer and turkey harvested on Fort Knox are **bonus** animals and are in addition to the Kentucky bag limits.

Additional antlerless permits may be purchased.
