

2022 Archery Antlerless Deer Harvest Log Anderson, Thorne, and Wilson Hunting Areas

All deer harvested at Fort Knox must be checked-in through the KDFWR's Telecheck System (www.fw.ky.gov or 1-800-245-4263) by midnight on the day it is harvested. Select Hardin (047) county, then Public Land, then Fort Knox Military Reservation. Harvest must also be reported at check-out in the iSportsman system. The confirmation number obtained from the KDFWR's Telecheck System must be recorded on this Harvest Log. When a deer is harvested, you must immediately record the sex, date, time, and Hunting Area before the animal is moved. A carcass tag is required if a harvested deer leaves the hunter's possession for any reason. A carcass tag can be handwritten and must include the hunter's name and phone number.
