SPECIAL GUIDELINES FOR ARCHERY DEER HUNTING IN HERITAGE, RICHARDSON, AND TA11

- 1. Hunters that wish to hunt in these hunting areas will reserve areas and check-in/out using iSportsman on a first-come, first-served basis, the same as any other hunting area.
- 2. Hunters must stay within the boundaries as outlined on the Hunting Area Maps on the iSportsman website.
- 3. **Heritage, Richardson, and TA11 are antlerless deer areas**, except for Tier 1-2 hunters that apply and are drawn for an either-sex permit. Holders of a Fort Knox Fall Turkey Permit may also harvest 3 turkeys (fall archery and gun seasons combined, 1 bird per day, and no more than 1 bird may have a beard length of 3 inches or longer).
- 4. There will be no hunting within 100 yards of an improved road (asphalt or rock based), structure, or checkpoint. Bows and crossbows will be unloaded when not in use, when in/at a vehicle, when carried in a non-hunting area, during non-hunting hours, or after a hunter has taken the legal bag limit.
- 5. When hunting in Richardson all hunters will park either at the location depicted on the map, or along Main Range Road where it borders the area.
- 6. When hunting in TA11 there will be no parking along U.S. Highway 31W. Authorized parking areas are: along Brandenburg Station Road, Tow Dragon Road, and Dickerson Lake.
- 7. When hunting Heritage there will be no parking on 11th Avenue, Wilson Road, or Gold Vault Road. Hunters should avoid hunting near the fitness trail.
- 8. Due to the close proximity of these areas to the cantonment area, hunters must be extremely cautious and aware that there may be people and pets wandering in any of these areas.
- 9. Hunters hunting in these areas are expected to conduct themselves with the highest standard of ethics and safety.
- 10. All of the above requirements are in addition to the requirements in the Archery Deer Hunting Guidelines which apply to these areas as well.
