## 2025 FORT KNOX CANTONMENT AREA EITHER-SEX ARCHERY DEER HUNTING INFORMATION

(Heritage, TA 11, Richardson, Anderson, Thorne, Wilson)

- 1. A random drawing will be used to select **Tier 1 2 hunters** and assign permits for this hunt. A **non-refundable** application fee of \$15 is required and must be purchased on iSportsman prior to submitting application. Completed applications must be emailed to (<u>usarmy.knox.id-training.mbx.dpw-hunt-control@army.mil</u>), or brought to the Hunt Control Office by 31 August. We advise applicants to bring the completed application in person to ensure successful delivery.
- 2. Hunters drawn for one of these permits will be permitted to harvest: 1 antlerless deer or 1 antlered deer with an outside antler spread of at least 12 inches for selected dates only. Hunters will not take, or attempt to take, an antlered deer with an outside antler spread of less than 12 inches. An antlered deer is a deer with at least one antler 4 inches long or longer, as measured from the skin at the base of the antler to the furthermost tip. Bucks with only 1 antler are not legal 12-inch wide bucks.
- 3. This permit is in **addition** to the regular Fort Knox deer bag limit.
- 4. Hunters will be eligible for 1 hunting area on 1 of the date preferences listed on back/next page.
- 5. Hunters must designate their area and date preferences on the application. Number dates and areas in order of preference (1 through 83) and select only dates and areas that you are able to hunt. There will be absolutely no changing of dates or areas selected. Permits issued will only be valid for the hunter, dates, and area specified. All scouting of the area will be done prior to the season or during the days a hunter is drawn to hunt. There will be no hunting or scouting on Tuesdays or specified holidays when the Hunt Control Office is closed.
- 6. Hunters selected will be notified **by email through iSportsman** and can print the permit from their account. Hunters must have a valid 2025 Fort Knox Archery Deer Permit in their possession prior to receiving this permit. Hunters will have priority for these areas for the dates indicated on the permit. Hunters drawn for an area that is closed due to military training during the time selected will have their application fee refunded.
- 7. All hunters must follow the same reservation and check-in/out procedures through iSportsman as is required of all archery deer hunters. Refer to the 2025 Fort Knox Archery Hunting Guidelines for reservation and check-in/out procedures and all other archery deer hunting rules.
- 8. Some areas may experience traffic from other recreational activities, potentially impacting area access.
